## COWBOY ROSS RULES GOVERNING EXHIBITORS

1. The space as stipulated in this agreement is to be used only for the Exhibitor named in this contract during the dates specified. You **MUST** check in with the Event Coordinator **BEFORE** setting up, this includes those vendors who are new or returning vendors.
2. The price paid for the exhibit space shall include: said space and fluorescent lighting under pavilion. The price of an outdoor space is net and does not include lighting. You must stay inside the space you leased as you will have neighbors. Parking is limited therefore you will be issued only 2 passes to park and 2 armbands for each 10X10 space. All other armbands will be \$5 each.
3. The Exhibitor must provide all fixtures (i.e., 100' extension cord, tables, chairs, lights) in exhibit area. Any vendor selling any kind of food **must** have a fire extinguisher with a current date.
4. All improvements erected on said space shall be done at the expense of the Exhibitor; subject, however, to the approval of Cowboy Ross. Upon termination of an exhibit, all of said improvements should be removed at the expense of the Exhibitor, leaving the space in as good as condition as it was when it was occupied.
5. Goods may be sold from the booth providing the sales are not in competition with Cowboy Ross concessionaires such as all food confections, beverages of all kinds, merchandise sold by Cowboy Ross as official souvenirs and novelties sold by the carnival/midway.
6. All Cowboy Ross Grounds remain under the control of Cowboy Ross and no demonstrators, banners, decorations, or advertising matter or special exhibits will be permitted except by prior approval.
7. The Exhibitor will not be permitted to exhibit any articles other than those approved in the application or display and advertise signs except his own.
8. Cowboy Ross reserves the right to remove or prohibit exhibits which for any reason are deemed objectionable and in their judgment may detract from the general character of the event. This reservation includes persons, things, conduct, printed matter, or anything else, which in the opinion of Cowboy Ross is unacceptable. If music is played, keep it low and nothing vulgar.
9. The Exhibitor is entirely responsible for the space leased and he/she agrees to reimburse Cowboy Ross for any damages, which occur in the space, leased by the Exhibitor.
10. The Exhibitor will be solely responsible for his/her merchandise and exhibit. Cowboy Ross will not assume responsibility for theft or weather damage to merchandise.
11. The Exhibitor is responsible for submitting all applicable taxes directly to the proper agencies.
12. The lease, these rules and regulations, and any other oral or written rules prescribed by Cowboy Ross shall be final and any violation thereof shall constitute default of the lease. Violation of this can mean immediate cancellation of any agreement and forfeiture of all rental monies.
13. Absolutely no roving vendors allowed on Cowboy Ross Grounds.
14. No cars, recreation vehicles or other motorized vehicles are allowed in the Exhibit Area of the Festival Grounds during specified hours. Once your products are unloaded each day, your vehicle is to be moved to the designated parking area. Violation of this rule may cause expulsion.
